Write a letter to a friend in England telling him/her about your school or college and its facilities and what you can do there.

You could write about:

- What facilities the school or college has
- What you can do at the school or college
- What you like about the school or college
- What you don't like about the school or college

Write 75 - 100 words or a minimum of 15 sentences.

You will be assessed on:

- content
- word order
- use of appropriate tenses
- use of conjunctions, adjectives and vocabulary
